



Bereavement Travel Program Description

How does Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s Bereavement Travel Program work?

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s (NTI) Bereavement Travel Program provides financial assistance for air travel for a maximum of two (2) family members who wish to travel to attend the funeral of a family member in another Nunavut community.

Who is eligible?

- The deceased must be a family member. Eligible relatives include grand-mother, grandfather, mother, father, daughter, son, aunt, uncle, sister, brother, grandchildren.
- NTI must receive a copy of the death certificate.
- The deceased be an immediate family member of a registered Beneficiary of the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* (NLCA).
- The recipients must be registered Beneficiaries of the NLCA.
- Families must work together to determine which family members are in most need of assistance.
- NTI will provide assistance to the individuals selected by the family. Community Liaison Officers will assist NTI in this area.
- Priority will be given to family members over the age of 16.

4. Airfares will be paid for two (2) qualifying persons.
