



## **Nunavut Harvester Support Program – Community Harvest Program Description**

### **How does Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s Nunavut Harvester Support Program – Community Harvest Program work?**

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s (NTI) Nunavut Harvester Support Program (NHSP) – Community Harvest Program is designed to provide financial assistance to Hunters and Trappers Organizations (HTOs) to organize a community harvest to benefit community members. Local HTOs may be provided with a maximum amount of \$3,000 to lead a community harvest.

Meat that is harvested can be distributed either by community feast or to selected members of the community, including Elders, families with no means of hunting, widowed people, youth, etc.

Financial assistance is also available for the operation and maintenance of HTO community boats through the Community Harvest Program. Financial assistance for marine hunting activity can be used to cover expenses like fuel and salaries.

### **Reporting Process**

Records of expenses incurred during the harvesting project must be maintained by the HTO Manager. A final report and financial statements must be submitted when the project is complete.
