



## **Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Travel Program Description**

### **How does Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Travel Program work?**

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s (NTI) Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Travel Program provides one-time financial assistance for an individual or group to travel to their nunatuqaminut (traditional lands) in Nunavut. Individuals can access a maximum of \$500 and groups can access a maximum of \$5,000.

### **Who is eligible?**

- Recipients must be registered Beneficiaries of the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* (NLCA).
- Families must work together to determine which family members are in most need of assistance.
- Nunatuqaminut is one-time only financial assistance.
- NTI will provide financial assistance on a first come, first serve basis.
- Proof of displacement is required.
- Priority will be given to family members over the age of 16.

### **How do Beneficiaries access the Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Travel Program?**

1. The Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Travel Program Application Form is available on NTI's website at [www.tunngavik.com](http://www.tunngavik.com) or by contacting the NTI office in Rankin Inlet at 1-888-236-5400 or (867) 645-5400.
2. The Nunatuqaminut (Traditional Lands) Program Application Form must be completed and submitted to NTI's office in Rankin Inlet.
3. On receipt of the completed Application Form and required documents, NTI will reimburse expenses to the maximum amount identified.
4. Recipients are required to submit to NTI a brief report on the financial expenditures incurred on the trip.
