**RIA Costs related to performing functions  
related to resource development**

**WHEREAS** the Regional Inuit Associations perform various functions mandated by the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* related to resource development activities such as administering lands, environmental review and negotiating Inuit impact and benefit agreements;

**AND WHEREAS** Nunavut has seen an increasing level of resource development activities in the past few years;

**AND WHEREAS** these activities bring economic benefits to Nunavut, but the Regional Inuit Associations are incurring additional expenses in performing the functions stated above;

**AND WHEREAS** while part of the RIA's additional expenses can be recouped from the mining companies and offset by some government funding, the financial shortfalls put additional pressure on Regional Inuit Associations' limited financial resources;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Members direct the Board of Directors to examine and explore more effective and efficient ways for the Regional Inuit Associations to perform the functions stated above, and to request additional funding from the Nunavut Trust to a maximum limit of two million dollars to cover Regional Inuit Associations' financial shortfalls.
