**AND WHEREAS** the Kivalliq Inuit Association is advocating for the establishment of a 24 hour health care facility in Rankin Inlet, and the Members of Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. support the efforts of the Kivalliq Inuit Association;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Members call on the Government of Nunavut to establish and maintain a long term 24 hour health care facility in Rankin Inlet that will service Kivalliq and surrounding communities.
