WHEREAS Elders and patients requiring 24 hour health care in the Kivalliq region are either temporarily placed at the in-patient ward at the Rankin Inlet Health Centre or sent to facilities outside the region, which negatively impacts the health and wellbeing of the patients;			
AND WHEREAS the Kivalliq Inuit Association is advocating for the establishment of a 24 hour health care facility in Rankin Inlet, and the Members of Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. support the efforts of the Kivalliq Inuit Association;			
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members call on the Government of Nunavut to establish and maintain a long term 24 hour health care facility in Rankin Inlet that will service Kivalliq and surrounding communities.
