Elders' Care in Nunavut Communities

WHEREAS Elders are the traditional knowledge holders of Inuit society and are respected for their leadership, experience, wisdom and compassion, among other things;

AND WHEREAS the Members expressed concerns about the adequacy of care for Elders in Nunavut communities, specifically the living conditions and the level of care for those in need of assistance in their daily lives;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT NTI Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to conduct a review of the adequacy of care for Elders in Nunavut communities including regular inspections of existing Elders' facilities and to upgrade these facilities where deficiencies exist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to allocate additional resources to ensure Elders receive adequate care in Nunavut.
