**Public Inquiry for Missing and Murdered
Indigenous Women and Girls**

Moved by: Raymond Ningeocheak

Seconded by: Stanley Anablak

WHEREAS, Indigenous women including Inuit across Canada have been murdered or reported missing at rates over four times the national average;

AND WHEREAS, Indigenous women and girls are three times more likely to be the victims of violent crime;

AND WHEREAS, there remains a gap in comprehensive analysis of contributing factors, environments, and systems that expose Indigenous women and girls to vulnerability for violence;

AND WHEREAS, Inuit women and girls remain largely neglected in the national narrative of missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Members call upon the Government of Canada to launch a public inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women in Canada; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Members call upon the Government of Canada to ensure adequate representation and participation of all Indigenous Canadian peoples including Inuit to guide and inform the inquiry process.
