Use of terms in Nunavut Agreement

WHEREAS it is important to use (1) an appropriate short title to refer to the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada* signed on May 9, 1993 (the "Agreement") and (2) an appropriate short form to refer to persons enrolled under that Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the use of the term "Nunavut Land Claims Agreement" (or NLCA for short) or "Beneficiaries" does not appropriately reflect the status, scope and nature of the Agreement and Inuit rights under it;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

- (a) in all future external and internal communications, NTI consistently use the term "Nunavut Agreement" rather than "Nunavut Land Claims Agreement;"
- (b) in all future external and internal communications, NTI consistently use the term "Nunavut Inuit" or, if context requires, "persons enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement, rather than "beneficiaries;"
- (c) NTI encourage Regional Inuit Associations to consider doing the same; and,
- (d) NTI request other parties, including the Government of Canada and Government of Nunavut, to respect this usage.
