Process**

IPG Appointment

WHEREAS pursuant to Article 11, 12 and 13 of the Nunavut Agreements and implementing legislation, NTI nominates certain members to the Nunavut Planning Commission, Nunavut Impact Review Board and Nunavut Water Board respectively (collectively known as the Institutions of Public Government or IPGs);

AND WHEREAS the Government of Canada appoints the IPG members nominated by NTI;

AND WHEREAS it often takes the Government of Canada an unreasonably long period of time to process an IPG appointment;

AND WHEREAS although the Government of Canada has indicated a willingness to work with NTI and Regional Inuit Associations to improve the appointment process, no concrete action or process has been put in place to systematically and effectively address the issue;

AND WHEREAS the unreasonably long processing time for IPG appointments has negatively impacted the operations of IPGs, including their ability to conduct meetings and hearings with an appropriate quorum, and has unnecessarily prolonged the approval process for mining projects, which would have brought much needed jobs and economic development activities to Nunavut communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members call on the Government of Canada to work with NTI to establish an IPG appointment process that would complete each IPG appointment expeditiously and within a reasonable period of time.
