Walrus Meat Testing Facility

WHEREAS Nunavut Inuit have been demanding that a Trichinella Testing Facility be established in Nunavut;

AND WHEREAS more walruses are harvested in the Nunavut Settlement Areas than in any other parts of Canada;

AND WHEREAS Nunavut Inuit have to send their harvest samples to a facility outside the territory to be tested for trichinella or other parasites, before they are able to consume their catch, as there is no laboratory in Nunavut;

AND WHEREAS the out of territory testing process is time consuming and the laboratory results are not always provided on a timely basis to the hunters;

AND WHEREAS during the 2012 NTI Annual General Meeting, the Members passed a resolution calling on the government to establish a testing facility in Nunavut;

AND WHEREAS the Nunavut Research Institute (NRI) has indicated a willingness to work with NTI to pilot a trichinella testing program at the Iqaluit laboratory facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members call on the Government of Nunavut and the Nunavut Research Institute to expedite the establishment of the pilot trichinella testing program in Nunavut, with an objective of establishing a long-term meat testing laboratory in Nunavut for walrus and other country meats.
