WHEREAS the Government of Nunavut abolished re education boards in 2000, as a cost-saving measure;	gional health boards and regiona
AND WHEREAS the abolition of the regional boards of NTI, the Regional Inuit Associations and Inuit gener Nunavut Agreement;	
AND WHEREAS through the regional boards, Inuit had the opportunity to participate in decision-making on the development and delivery of policies, programs and services in the important areas of education and health care;	
AND WHEREAS the abolition of those boards weakened Inuit participation and created significant gaps in the decision-making process, and devalued Inuit priorities and preferences on important decisions affecting their health care and their children's education;	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to re-establish education and health boards in Nunavut, with the participation of NTI and the Regional Inuit Associations, so as to ensure meaningful engagement and participation by Inuit in the decision-making process in the areas of education and health care in Nunavut.
