NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members call upon the Government of Nunavut and the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board to take all available measures to address the risks of dangerous polar bear encounters in Nunavut communities, and to revise any future polar bear management plans to fully incorporate Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit and to adequately address safety concerns, protection of property and country food, and the necessity to engage the tourism industry to address habituation of polar bears to humans.
