**Maximizing Use of Existing
Government Buildings and
Facilities in Communities**

WHEREAS there are existing government buildings and facilities in Nunavut communities that are not being used to their full capacity and potential;

AND WHEREAS there are tremendous needs for space in the communities to offer programs, services and gathering places such as for cultural/learning activities, daycares, men's groups, traditional skills training, etc. for the purpose of improving the lives and well-being of the residents in the communities;

AND WHEREAS these buildings and facilities are expensive to build and maintain, and under-utilization of these buildings/facilities represents an unnecessary waste of taxpayers' money and precious government resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to

1. conduct an assessment of current government buildings and facilities in all Nunavut communities including whether and to what extent each building/facility could be used for activities by residents in the community, and
2. take adequate and proactive steps to maximize the use of existing buildings and facilities by residents in the communities.
