**NITC**

**WHEREAS** the Nunavut Implementation Training Committee (NITC) funding has remained static for the last fifteen years, despite increasing demand for training and scholarship support among the Inuit of Nunavut and is near depletion; and

**WHEREAS** the mandate of NITC, under Article 37 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) is ongoing and needs to be fulfilled for the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS** NITC partner organizations will require ongoing funding for training as their roles expand in areas such as mining, commerce, government employment under Article 23 and the general promotion of Inuit social and economic well-being; and

**WHEREAS,** former Justice Thomas Berger made a recommendation in his final conciliator's report in March 2006 on the implementation of the NLCA, that the Government of Canada representing the Crown, must make new and immediate investments in training in order to fulfill the promises of the NLCA;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the members strongly urge the Government of Canada, as representing the Crown, to take immediate measures to replenish the NITC trust fund to a level fully adequate to meet the training needs of its partner organizations, and to enable NITC to fulfill its role under Article 37 of the NLCA.
