Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit

WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit has been passed down from generation to generation over centuries;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit embraces all aspects of Inuit culture, including values, traditions, wisdom, world-view, language, knowledge, life skills, perceptions and expectations;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit reflects the collective wisdom and strengths of the Inuit society, and has been the foundation for past, current and future generations of Inuit to survive and flourish;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit is more than a source of information, a collection of knowledge, or a compilation of abstract concepts and principles;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit is part of Inuit identity, and cannot be interpreted or represented by non-Inuit without Inuit consent or participation;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit, similar to other systems of information, knowledge, values or traditions, is also living and adapting, and evolving with Inuit life in the changing world;

AND WHEREAS Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit may not always be available in written form and Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit in oral form is as reliable, as authoritative and as valuable as other systems of information, knowledge, values or traditions that have been recorded in writing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Members stress that Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit is relevant and continues to provide essential guidance to every aspect of Inuit life today including political governance, economic development, workplaces, family relations and daily life;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Members call on Government, Institutions of Public Government, and other relevant bodies to recognize and respect the central role of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit in all aspects of life in Nunavut;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Members call on Government, Institutions of Public Government and other relevant bodies to integrate Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit into all aspects of their operations in Nunavut.
