The Department is responsible for activities related to NTI's obligations as the Designated Inuit Organization (DIO) under Article 32 of the *Nunavut Agreement*.

- Knowledge of social/cultural-related issues affecting Inuit in Nunavut.
- Good knowledge of the Nunavut Agreement and NTI's Mission, especially Article 32.
- Knowledge of NTI's Corporate Governance system.
- Demonstrated awareness of and sensitivity to Inuit issues.
- Knowledge of regional, territorial, national, and international Inuit organizations.
- Experience in negotiating with Government.
- Strong presentation skills.
- Fluency in Inuktitut or Inuinnaqtun or the willingness to undertake training to attain fluency is a must.
