NTI Response to Ikajuqtigiikta – the 7th Nunavut Legislative Assembly’s Mandate

(March 23, 2026 – Iqaluit, Nunavut) Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI)

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. (NTI) is pleased to see the priorities identified in *Ikajuqtigiikta*, the 7th Assembly’s mandate released today. The commitment to strengthen Inuit self determination through the implementation of the *Nunavut Agreement* and the four pillars identified in *Ikajuqtigiikta* align with NTI’s organizational priorities outlined in *Inungnik Makipalliatittiniq 2025-2029*.

“NTI remains committed to working constructively with the Government of Nunavut (GN) and Members of the Legislative Assembly to advance our shared priorities, namely in the areas of housing, pre-employment training and Inuit employment plans, mental health and elder care” said President Irgaut.

NTI and the GN renewed the Nunavut Partnership Committee in December 2025 and within the *Katujjiqatigiinniq Protocol*, both parties have agreed to strengthen working relations and increase accountability.
